



- 3. Add in app name, description, launch path, icon file name, developer name, and URL






Sending Files to Corporate Central Support

- 4. Attach your 128\*128 icon and manifest.webapp file




Sending Files to Corporate Central Support (Cont.)

Submitting App to Firefox Marketplace




- 1. Go to marketplace.firefox.com/developers/submit

- 5. Click Continue






Submitting App to Firefox Marketplace (Cont.)
